Adjustable range




Seat Height Adjustment

Adjust the seat height using the seat height adjustment lever on the bottom right of the seat. The seat will be lowered if you lift the lever while seated, and it will stop at any position you release the lever at. The seat will be raised if you lift the lever while not seated on the seat



Seat depth adjustment

Adjust the seat depth by sliding the seat forward or back within a range of 50 mm (2") using the Seat slide lever on the bottom left of the seat. This allows for maintaining an appropriate distance between the back and the front edge of the seat, reducing pressure on the back of the knees and providing reliable support for the lower back.



4. Operation guide (continued)

Reclining adjustment

Before adjusting the backrest recline, release the lock by using the reclining lock/ release dial on the bottom left of the seat. Set the dial to (B) to recline the backrest. If you want to adjust the backrest recline to the front position, set the dial to (A). In (A), you can also adjust the backrest recline to the back position.

To lock the backrest recline, turn the dial clockwise once. After locking the backrest recline, you can release it by turning the



dial counterclockwise once, and leaning

against the backrest lightly.


Dial position to lock and release the backrest recline


Turn the reclining lock/release dial to the (A), (B), or (C) position to lock and release the backrest recline.



Backrest recline to the BACK position

The backrest recline can be adjusted within a range of 23°.

- (1) Turn the dial to (B) to release the lock. If the dial is already set to (B), turn it to (A).
- (2) Move the backrest recline to the BACK position.
- (3) Turn the dial to (C) to lock the backrest recline.
- * If you want to release the lock again, turn the dial counterclockwise once, and lean against the back lightly.

Backrest curve adjustment feature

Adjust the reclining tension by using the reclining tension adjustment dial on the bottom right of the seat.

The tension to the backrest will be increased if you turn the dial clockwise (+), and the tension will be decreased if you turn the dial counterclockwise (-). Adjust it so that it is comfortable.




Adjustable arm (option) height adjustment

The backrest curve will be loosened (A) if you pull down the levers on both sides of the backrest, and the curve will be tightened (B) if you pull up the levers. Adjust the curve so that your back comfortably fits the backrest.

- * When rotating the adjustable arms, make sure to hold the edge of the arms.

Hanger (option) height adjustment

Adjust the Hanger by pushing the button. The Hanger can be moved up and down within a range of 120 mm $(4 \ 3/4'')$. The Hanger can also be set in a position where it is out of the way when not in use, allowing for a clean appearance.

If you use the Hanger with the lowbackrest seat, adjust the Hanger to the highest position.

6. Instructions to Extend the Life of Product

For maintenance

- Regular maintenance is for long product life.
- If found unstable due to loose bolts and screws, tighten them.
- For daily care, use a well-wrung soft cloth.
- For stained part, use neutral detergent (1-3%) and completely remove detergent with dry soft cloth.



Daily care

[Cloth part]

- Brush with a soft brush or tap the surface softly and vacuum to remove dust to avoid damaging the cloth.
- When it gets dirty after extended period of time, wipe with a well wrung soft cloth moistened with thin neutral detergent. Wipe clean with a damp cloth. Be sure to wipe detergent completely and wipe again with a dry cloth to dry it.
- When using alkaline electrolyzed water to remove stains, spray directly on the stain and brush with a soft brush taking care not to damage the cloth. Then, wipe the moisture and stain to remove and wait for the cloth to dry.
- When it gets an oily stain, dab and remove it by using a dedicated stain remover immediately. Then wipe with a soft cloth dampened with water, followed by a dry cloth to dry. Stains may be permanent depending on the material.

- For mesh and cushion parts, remove dust by tapping the cloth surface with brush or using vacuum cleaner.
- Cushion cannot be drycleaned. Replacing is recommended if exceptionally dirty.



Please be careful. -

Do not leave the product with moisture remaining on it. Do not clean the product with organic solvents such as thinner or benzene, or with a cloth that contains chemicals. Be aware that once discoloration or deterioration happens, it cannot be reverted to its original state.

[Aluminum part]

- Wipe off with a dry soft clean cloth.
- Immediately wipe off any water.
- Immediately wipe off any dust or fingerprints (sebum).

[Resin Part]

- Wipe with a well wrung soft cloth moistened.
- If dirt is noticeable, wipe it off with a well wrung soft cloth moistened with thin neutral detergent. Be sure to remove detergent completely with a damp cloth and wipe again with a dry cloth to dry it.
